Change in Sunday Mass Schedule

Beginning on September 9, 2007, our Sunday Mass schedule will change. Sunday Masses will be held at 8AM, 9:30AM, 11AM (Solemn Mass, upper church), 11AM (Family Mass, Wallace Hall), and 7:30PM. The anticipated Mass for Sunday will continue at 5:30PM on Saturdays. In making this change, we are returning to a schedule more like the one in effect for many years prior to 2004. Having both the Solemn Mass and the Family Mass at 11AM will allow us once again to have a common coffee hour in Wallace Hall after the Masses.
