SUMMER SCHEDULE

THE CHURCH WILL BE CLOSED FROM JUNE 30 to AUGUST 31, 2008. Our weekend Masses will be held in Wallace Hall. Our daily Masses at 8:30AM and 5:30PM will be in the Lady Chapel. (No 12:10PM Mass beginning June 30). During this time, the major restoration work which was part of the Bicentennial Campaign will be accomplished. Pews will be removed, repaired and restored; new kneelers will be installed. The center section of pews will be returned before September 1, 2008; the side pews by September 12. The bronze doors, pulpit and choir screen will be restored and the bronze rosettes, missing on the leather doors, will be replaced. The Church and Narthex will be cleaned and painted and the marble walls and altars will be cleaned and painted. New lighting will be installed for the apse, the mosaics behind the altar, the main altar area and the columns at the clerestory. The floor will be replaced and the lower stained glass windows and baptistry cleaned, repaired and restored. The second half of the stained glass windows (the ones at the very highest level of the Church) will be done in July 2009. Generous contributions to the Bicentennial Campaign have allowed for this work to be accomplished.

NOTE: THE PARISH HOUSE WILL BE CLOSED ON FRIDAY, JULY 4. Mass will be at 8:30AM only.
