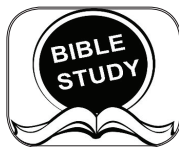

Thank You! The number of toys, games, books, and costumes brought to the Parish House for The Taconic Children's Center in Bedford Hills was astounding:

- 132 stuffed animals
- Over 250 games and 2,000 books
- 20 containers of arts and crafts materials
- 24 large garbage-size bags of toys (herds of dinosaurs, fleets of trucks, piles of pink things)
- Plus, two 48-inch boxes stuffed with costumes, a large dollhouse, carriages and other things on wheels, a chalk board, musical instruments, a bushel basket full of balls, etc.

Because so many items were collected, Sr. Tesa Fitzgerald, Executive Director and Co-Founder of Hour Children (which sponsors the children's centers), will be able to stock a children's center at the Beacon minimum security prison for women, in addition to the center at Taconic. Also, mothers in prison can now choose a book and be videotaped reading it. Hour Children will then deliver the tape and the book to the mother's child.

Sr. Tesa is deeply grateful for the generosity shown by the parishioners of St. Ignatius Loyola.
