During this time the 12:10 PM Daily Mass is discontinued, and both the 8:30 AM and 5:30 PM Masses are celebrated in the Lady Chapel.

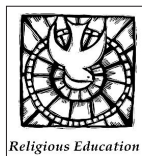

Dear Parish Family,

You may know that our beloved Associate Organist, Nancianne Parrella, has been on medical leave for the last six months. I'm happy to report that she is doing well, and you will be pleased to know that her beautiful playing will grace our Masses this weekend.

However, it is with a heavy heart that I relay to you that after intensive consultation with her family, Nancianne has decided to retire from her position here at St. Ignatius effective July 31, 2015. Three factors play into this decision: First, Nanci resides full-time in Cincinnati, in close proximity to one of her daughters, and has been flying in every weekend to be with us. The physical demands of travel on that scale are obvious. She will be able to spend less time on airplanes, and more time with her family. Second, Nanci has had two major surgeries in the last few months, and although her recovery has gone quite well, she is cognizant of the difficulty of maintaining her current schedule. Finally, the generosity of the Archdiocese has made it possible for her to retire with a good measure of security, and I am personally grateful on her behalf.

Nanci's career is by no means over. She will be in New York City several times over the coming season playing concerts and recitals, one of which will be a recital she and I will share next spring. There is also a rich and vibrant musical scene in Cincinnati to which she will be able to lend her considerable wisdom and experience.

This fall (date TBD) we will gather to celebrate her 22 years at St. Ignatius, her appointment as our Organist Emeritus, and a milestone birthday (I'll leave it to her to tell you which one!). I'll keep you in the loop!
