Our summer **Daily Mass Schedule** runs through Friday, September 4th.

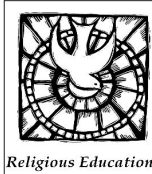
During this time the 12:10 PM Daily Mass is discontinued, and both the 8:30 AM and 5:30 PM Masses are celebrated in the Lady Chapel.
