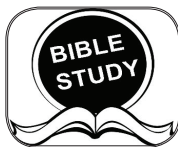

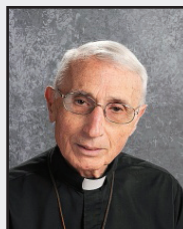

(from an email dated July 26th)

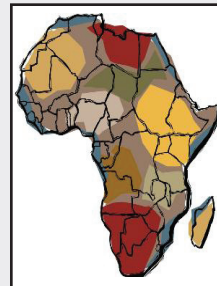


I am now halfway through my stay in Africa. I have already been to Nigeria and had extraordinary reunions with people I hadn't seen in more than 35 years. I also went to Port Harcourt and was astounded

at how it had grown. I have now been in Zambia for a little over a week. Yesterday I celebrated Mass in the parish, and it was as if I had never left.

I have also been twice to celebrate Mass at the Poor Clare Monastery, and was given a very warm reception. I am living at the Jesuit Novitiate and am encouraged by the young men in training here. The time is going fast.

[Soon] I move to another town for the priestly ordinations on the feast of St. Ignatius. Then it will be up to the Copperbelt, and finally back to Lusaka on August 7th before flying to Ghana on the 12th.



You are not forgotten and I [look forward to sharing my experiences when I return.] I miss all of you and have offered Mass for your intentions. God bless.
